

ACTIONS AGREEMENT

1. ACTION ORIENTATED

We are action orientated. We spend more time doing direct action than talking about it. Planning and preparation is key, but we keep it in the right proportion. We are focused on sustained actions, rather than one off actions. Our actions are intentional and goal focused.

We will be most successful if we stay focused and action orientated.

2. NO PERMISSION SOUGHT

We do not need to seek permission from the police or other authorities for our actions. We are not interested in waiting for the government or authorities to shut evil companies down, we do this ourselves. We do not speak about actions to anyone outside the group or share identities of anyone who is participating in actions. We do not provide police or authorities with any information that may compromise activists, actions or the movement. This keeps both activists and the movement safe and keeps the momentum going.

3. CAUSE COMES FIRST

The cause of ending complicity with Israeli apartheid is our aim and comes before everything else. We support each other in staying focused and motivated to keep our attention and energy on shutting down companies complicit in Israeli apartheid.

4. COMMITMENT

If you say you will do something, then ensure that you are committed to doing so. A couple people bailing out last minute because they committed when unsure if they were able to do it, can compromise a whole action. If you are unsure if you are able to commit to an action, be honest. This will allow the group to plan accordingly. We don't back down to pressure from authorities, liberal or dissenting voices within and without the movement. If we have an alliance of the willing, we carry on, despite the obstacles that may arise.

5. DISRUPT & DESTROY

Our actions seek to disrupt, damage and destroy complicit companies. So make sure any actions are in line with any or all of these goals.

6. FOCUSED TARGETS

Elbit Systems and associated companies are our targets. The only way this will stop, is when we shut Elbit down. **We can win if we stay focused.**

7. NEED TO KNOW BASIS

All our actions work on a need to know basis. **If you need to know it, you'll know it. If you don't, you won't. It's as simple as that.** This ensures actions and activists won't be compromised.

8. RECORD

Although media is not our main aim, it is imperative to our success that all actions are recorded either via video or photos. If there's no record, it didn't happen. **Elbit isn't going to promote our actions, we are our own media team, and must ensure actions are recorded as such.** Videos and photos of actions for social media contribute greatly to growing the movement. Be sure that if you are recording a covert action, no one in the video or photos can be identified.

9. FREE WILL

Each individual takes part in the movement from their own free will. If you choose to use your privilege to take a stand against racism, and take direct action to shut Elbit down, then that is your own choice. We encourage all to join and take direct action, but we do not pressure people into doing things that make them uncomfortable. We do encourage people to get involved with actions that meet their comfort level.

10. DON'T BE A DICKHEAD

If you're racist or sexually abusive or aggressive then that's not tolerated and you will be asked to leave immediately. On the other hand, if you say something that is tricky, another member may discuss it with you after the meeting. This does not apply to standard street speech (swearing) or working-class banter. We are not about being precious. Our movement will be most successful if we all contribute to supporting each other, not putting each other down. **We work together to meet our goals.**
